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## Patrol Menu and Duty Roster

### Job Descriptions

#### Duty

#### Responsibilities

Patrol Leader

Coordinate and oversee patrol operations. Assign tasks as needed. Help out where needed (leading by example).

Assistant Patrol Leader

Assist the Patrol Leader. Act as Patrol Leader in his absence.

Cooking

Prepare the meal, according to the planned menu and recipe (if relevant). Use proper safety and cleanliness (avoid leaving a mess).

Cleanup

Clean food preparation and cooking areas. Wash and store patrol cook gear and personal dishes.

Fireman

Safely light and tend fire or stove. Insure adequate water for fire safety, as well as for drinking and cleanup. Extinguish and remove fires when done.

Inspector

Inspect the patrol area for trash. Put all trash in proper containers. Secure trash at night.



*Note: Remember to give consideration to Scouts that need to fulfill cooking requirements for Advancement:*

Tenderfoot #3: Help prepare and cook a campout meal  
Second Class #2f: Light a fire and a cooking stove  
Second Class #2g: Cook a hot lunch or breakfast  
First Class #4e: Supervise as head cook for three meals  
Cooking Merit Badge: All requirements
